## Slow Cooker Chicken Stroganoff



Servings: 8

## **Ingredients**

- 1 large onion, chopped
- 1.5 pounds skinless chicken thighs (cut into ¾-inch cubes)
- 8 oz. fresh mushrooms (or 10z. frozen)
- 1 can Cream of Mushroom soup
- ½ Tbl. garlic powder
- ½ Tbl. fresh thyme (or ½ tsp. ground)
- 2 Tbl. tapioca
- ½ Tbl. mushroom or chicken bouillon (I use the *Better Than Bouillon* brand)
- ½ c. water
- 1c. light sour cream
- 8 oz. frozen green peas

## **Directions:**

- 1. Layer onion, mushrooms then meat.
- 2. Mix the garlic, thyme, tapioca, bouillon, and soup with the water
- 3. Pour soup mixture over meat
- 4. Cook 41/2 hours on HIGH, or 10 hours on LOW
- 5. Turn off slow cooker
- 6. Mix in sour cream and peas
- 7. Enjoy over your choice of rice or noodles (*I use a rice cooker with rice available all the time*)
